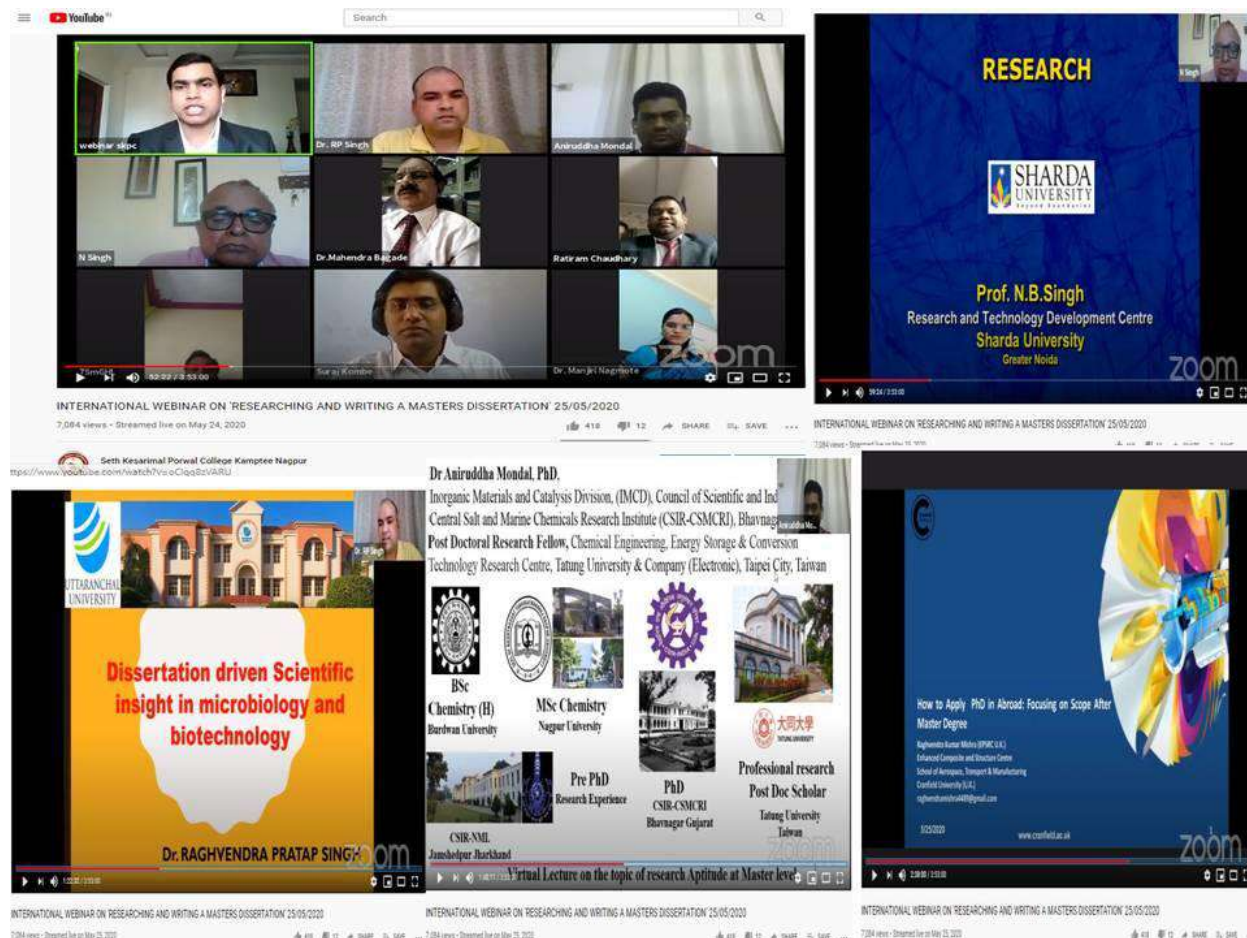


International Webinar on 25th May 2020
